

URDC CREATES HEALTHIER, SAFER HOMES

BY ASSISTING SENIOR AND LOW-INCOME FAMILIES PAY FOR HOME REPAIRS

The Urban Resources Development Corporation (URDC) is an interdenominational non-profit, working to stabilize housing and communities in Germantown, Mt. Airy, East/West Oak Lane, and other northwest Philadelphia communities by helping seniors and low-income families pay for home repairs. The organization is managed by 12 congregations, including St. Vincent de Paul.

Since 2005, URDC's Home Repair Program has helped over 650 senior and low-income homeowners pay for exterior home repairs through low-interest loans, grants, and volunteer programs. This includes over 40 repairs for 37 members of St. Vincents. Their work create healthier, safer homes for these families, improves the neighborhood, and allows seniors to "age in place", remaining in their homes to live with dignity and self-sufficiency.

St. Vincent's is a proud supporter of URDC – the organization helps two homeowners every week pay for their home repairs. Help keep URDC's work going in our community!
